RACE COURSE - Approximately 700 mile course loop starting and finishing in Ensenada on Boulevard Costero in front of the Riviera Convention Center.

OFFICIAL GPS FILE - All race teams are strongly advised to prerun and race using the official GPS file.

PRERUNNING - Prerunning opens on Friday, November 4. Please refer to the Prerunning Rules Bulletin for details.

PHYSICAL CHECKPOINTS - Racers are required to enter the six physical full-stop checkpoints in a single file manner and make a full and complete stop at the stop sign. The checkpoint corridor is not considered part of the race course. Entering and exiting all checkpoints must be done in a safe and prudent manner in order to guarantee the safety of checkpoint workers. Passing is not permitted 300 feet before a checkpoint. Pitting is not permitted within 300 feet before and 100 feet after a checkpoint.

VIRTUAL CHECKPOINTS - The race course has 64 Virtual Checkpoints (VCPs). The VCPs are strategically placed to discourage shortcutting. However, the VCPs do not represent the only areas that require compliance. The entire course will be reviewed for compliance.

FINISH LINE STOP - A full and complete stop is required at the finish line checkered flag. This stop must be made in a safe and controlled manner.

WEATHERMAN RELAY - SCORE will use 151.625 for the main race operations radio frequency. Please use this frequency to report an emergency or ask for help.

TOWING RULES - Towing is not permitted within one mile of the finish line. However, wristbanded vehicle occupants are permitted to push a disabled race vehicle across the finish line. Also, towing is not permitted for more than 1% of the course, or 7.0 miles.

TIME LIMIT - All vehicles will have 32 hours from their designated start time to complete the race.

STARTING GAP - There will be a full 4 hour gap between the last ATV starter and the first Trophy Truck starter.

IRC TRACKING DEVICES - These devices are mandatory in order to verify compliance with the published rules regarding course deviations and highway speed zones. Please review the IRC bulletin for detailed information.
